



Understanding the importance of responsibility for our personal possessions and needs is an integral part of learning and maturing into a productive, confident member of our community. For this reason the charging policy for school lunches is intentionally progressive making allowances for the various stages of maturity experienced by our students as they grow to adulthood.

FOOD SERVICE POLICY FOR CHARGING LUNCH PURCHASES

Because a hungry child cannot learn, we feed our elementary students; parents must reimburse Palisades Food Service for the full cost of lunches purchased on credit.

At the middle school, we will allow students to charge only six (6) lunches. Once this limit has been reached, middle school students will be refused cafeteria service until their debt is paid and funds have been added to lunch accounts for future purchases. Time permitting, we will make an effort to notify parents at the end of the fourth day to avoid refusal of service, but it will be the responsibility of the student to keep his/her account current.

At the high school, no food purchases may be made on credit. Lunch service will be refused.

[Please note that legal action may be pursued to collect negative balances.]
