## **No. 105 AR – CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT**

Once every five years, each curricular area will undergo a comprehensive review of its curriculum to ensure alignment with standards, current research, and established best practice.

The review process will include input and involvement from teachers, administrators, students, parents, and community members.

The result/product of this review will be a report that is aligned to the district's comprehensive plan and presented to the Board Educational Programs and Services Committee. It will contain the following:

- Department mission and vision
- Review of student performance data
- Goals
- Action steps to achieve goals that span a five-year period
- Resources necessary to achieve action steps which must include textbook selection

Proposed textbooks will be available for the Education Programs and Services Committee and full Board for examination and review when the textbook is being adopted for the first time. Subsequent editions of the same textbook do not need to be separately reviewed & approved.

NOTE: The five-year cycle may be extended or shortened based on changes to required standards or department needs, as approved by the Superintendent.
